Physical Address of Show Grounds: 3563 Pedley Ave, Norco, CA 92860

Directions/Parking: From I-15 north or south, exit 6th Street and go east.

Turn right at the stop light on California Ave and go approximately ½ mile.

Entrance is on the right, marked by a plywood sign leaning against a chain link fence.

Plenty of pull-through parking. Trailers cannot use the Pedley entrance during shows.

The back gate is opened on Friday of show weekends.

Cars without trailers must park in the back lot or at the Pedley Ave entrance.

Licensing: This is a B-Rated Working Equitation competition licensed by WE United (**yes**, that means points earned at these events will count toward your **Year End Awards** and **Lifetime Rider Medals!**).

Format of the Show: one day

Dressage tests will start at 8:00 am, followed by EOH, then Speed.

Due to time constraints of a one-day show, we will only be accepting 15 entries, so please don't delay if you would like to enter!

Prizes

Ribbons 1st – 5th for each trial.

Champion/Reserve rosettes for overall winners in each class (combining points earned in all trials).

An additional award will be offered to the person with the highest combined Dressage and Ease of Handling percentages, across all levels.

Note: All classes will be run as Open classes unless there is a sufficient number of entries to justify splitting into divisions. A class will be split into Open/Amateur/Youth divisions provided there will still be at least three or more entries in each of the split classes. In the case of a split, ribbons will be awarded to each of the split classes.

Entry Fees:

Level 1 (Intro) = \$75 per entry.

Level 2 (Novice A) thru Level 5 (Intermediate B) = \$125 per entry.

State Drug Fee + Grounds Fee + WE United Starter Fee = \$22 per entry.

WE United Non-Member Fee = \$15 per non-member.

Entry fee covers all trials offered at each level. Riders participating as Training Wheel Riders, as well as those schooling hors concours, pay the same entry free.

Stabling: Stalls will be available on site.

Mare Motel = \$15/day

Box Stall (with run) = \$25/day

There is no additional charge to show out of your trailer.

Option for Those New to the Sport: We are offering riders the opportunity to participate in this event as "Training Wheels Riders". Training Wheels Riders can have a coach, on foot, with them in the competition arena throughout their rides. The coach is available to assist both verbally (providing instructions / suggestions) and physically (assisting with the gate, etc.) to help ensure that both horse and rider have a positive experience with the sport. Training Wheels Riders are participating for schooling purposes only; they are not competing for awards/points. If you do not have a coach of your own, competition organizers will attempt to locate someone with WE experience at the event to serve as your coach during the event; however, competition management does not guarantee that a suitable coach can be found. The more advanced notice event management has about the potential for a coach being needed, the greater likelihood that a coach can be found for you.

Rules

The competitions will use the *United States Rules for Working Equitation*. Please make sure you have a copy of the current rules. They can be found on www.WEUnited.us -- go to the link for "Rules & Dressage Tests".

All horses must be registered with WE United. Lifetime Horse Recording with WE United is 100% free! Go to: <https://goo.gl/forms/Hjn40NAe81aT2HRL2> to register your horse.

Although membership in WE United is not required to compete at these shows, we strongly encourage all participants to join the National organization. Your \$25 annual membership fee helps support the continued development of the sport in the United States and helps fund the Performance Awards Programs, Judge and Technical Delegate Trainings, website, and outreach programs the organization offers. Join online at www.WEUnited.us. For riders' scores at a competition to count toward performance awards the riders must be a member within 30 days after the conclusion of the show. Anyone who is not a current member of WE United must pay a \$15 non-member fee to compete. Riders schooling hors concours and those participating solely in exhibition / leadline classes are exempt from this non-member fee, as they are not competing.

*****Use of helmets is required for all competitors whenever they are mounted*****

Liability Release

All competitors will be required to sign the liability release before being allowed to compete. Those entering online will sign the release when they check in at the show office. Those mailing their entry in should sign the release and include it with their entry form.
